Definition and purpose

Cookies are small pieces of data, stored in text files, which are stored on your computer or another device when websites are loaded in a browser. By default, almost all web browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. They are widely used to "remember" you and your preferences, either for a single visit (through a "session cookie") or for multiple repetitive visits (using a "persistent cookie"). They provide a consistent and efficient experience for visitors and perform essential functions such as allowing users to register and stay connected.

Cookies can be set by the site you are visiting (called "proprietary cookies") or by third parties, or by a website other than the one the user is visiting, such as those who provide content or provide advertising or analysis services on the website ("third-party cookies"). This is because on each site may be present elements (images, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages of other domains, etc.) that reside on servers other than the site visited. Both Web sites and HTML emails can also contain other tracking technologies such as "web beacons" or "pixels". These are typically small transparent images that provide statistics for purposes similar to cookies. They are often used in conjunction with cookies, although they are not stored on your computer in the same way. As a result, if you disable cookies, web beacons may still load, but their functionality will be limited.

Cookies can be used for different purposes. Some cookies are necessary for technical reasons; some allow a personalized experience for both visitors and registered users; and some allow the display of advertisements from selected third-party networks. Some of these cookies can be set when a page is loaded or when a visitor performs a particular action (by clicking on the "Like" or "Follow" button of a post, for example). Many of the cookies we use are only set if you are a registered user (so you do not have to log in each time, for example), while others are set each time you visit our Website, regardless of whether you have an account.

Because we respect your right to privacy, you can refuse certain types of cookies. "Technical" cookies

These cookies are used to make browsing or to provide a service requested by the user. They are not used for other purposes and are normally installed directly by the owner of the website. Technical cookies can be further divided into:

- Functionality cookies, which allow the user to navigate according to a series of selected criteria (for example, the language, the products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service provided.

"Profiling" cookies

These are the cookies used to track the user's browsing on the web and create profiles on his tastes, habits, choices, etc. With these cookies, advertising messages can be transmitted to the user's terminal in line with the preferences already expressed by the same user in the online navigation.
